Creating a Home Games Advantage Initiative

ONOC is leading this **INITIATIVE** for the Pacific Islands Sports Stakeholders, including the Oceania
Paralympic Committee (OPC)

The INITIATIVE was announced on 23rd July 2022, marking 10 years to the start of 2032 Brisbane Games

Brisbane 2032 provides Australia and the Pacific the opportunity to deliver on multiple outcomes encompassing High Performance Outcomes, Diplomacy Outcomes, Sustainable Capacity Building, Economic, Social and Community Engagement Outcomes.





Creating a Home Games Advantage



- With the 2000 Sydney Olympic Games, the Pacific Island NOCs and New Zealand (only one gold medal) were not able to take advantage of a "Home Games".
- Impetus to organise ourselves promptly to produce the best result ever by far, by the Pacific Islands, New Zealand and indeed Australia at their very own Home Games.
- Brisbane 2032 will require a new way of thinking, new levels of participation, performance and engagement creating new levels of outcomes.
